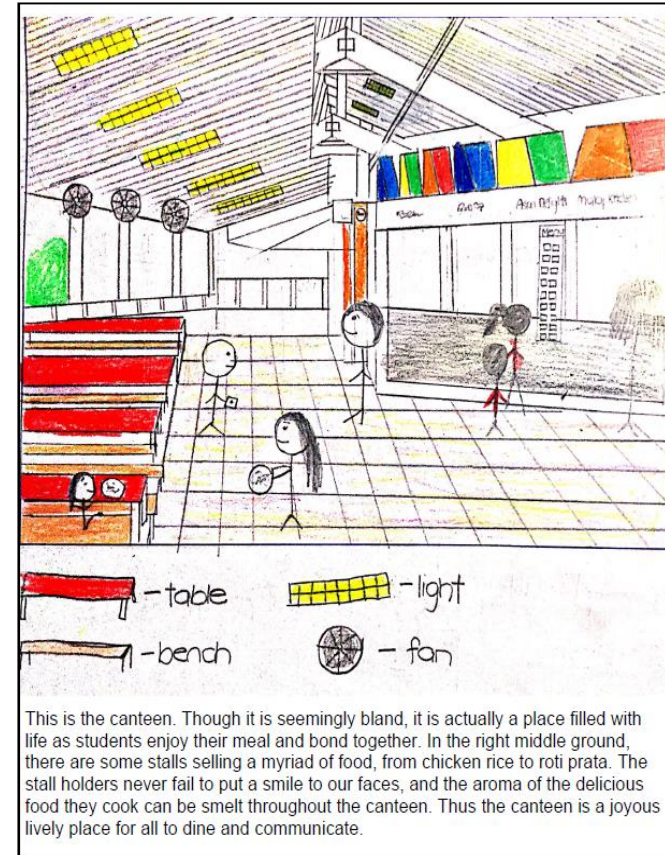

- Students who are on financial assistance schemes : Do NOT purchase first. HOD ICT will provide more info on first day of Orientation.

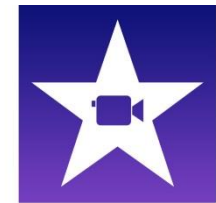

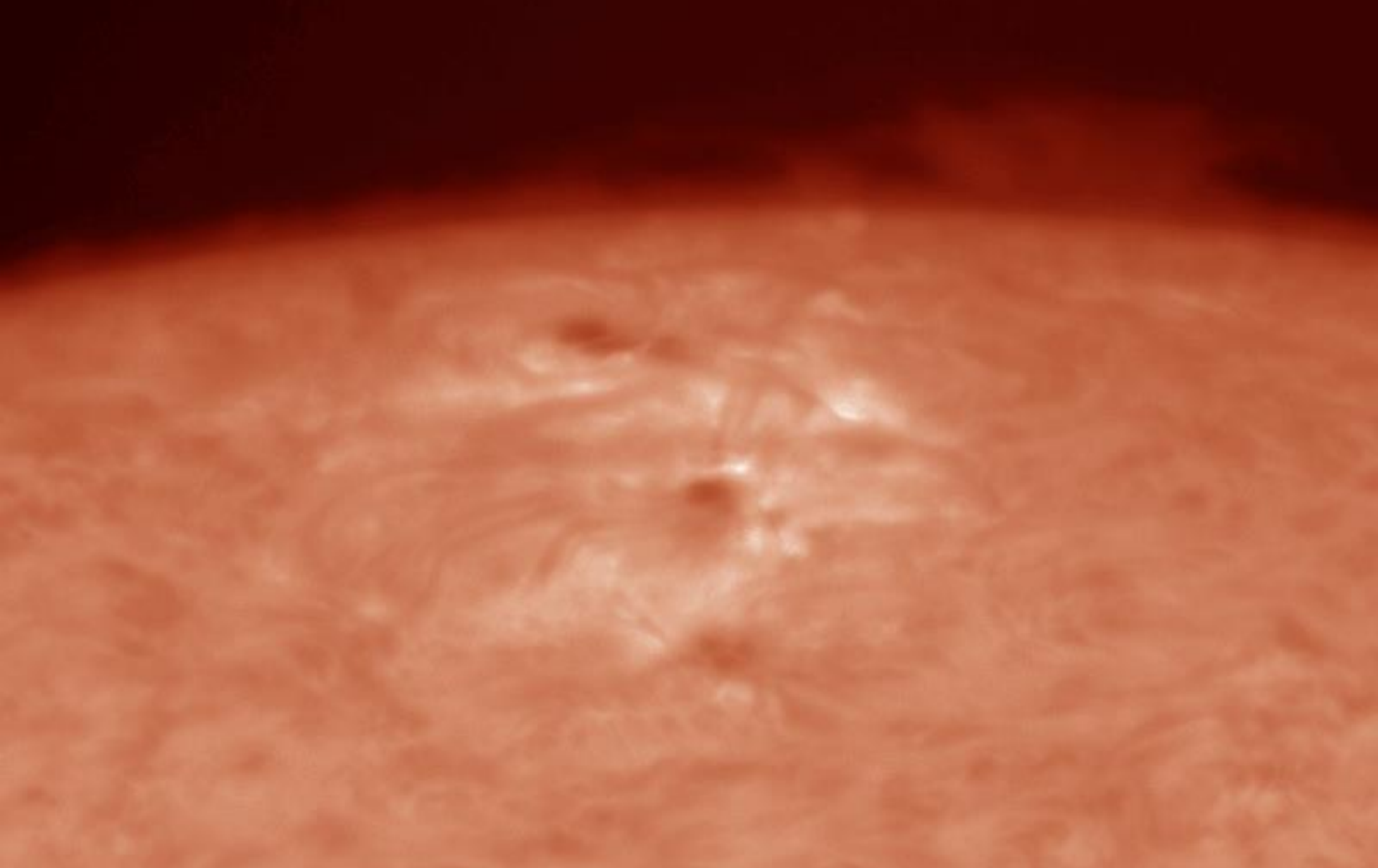

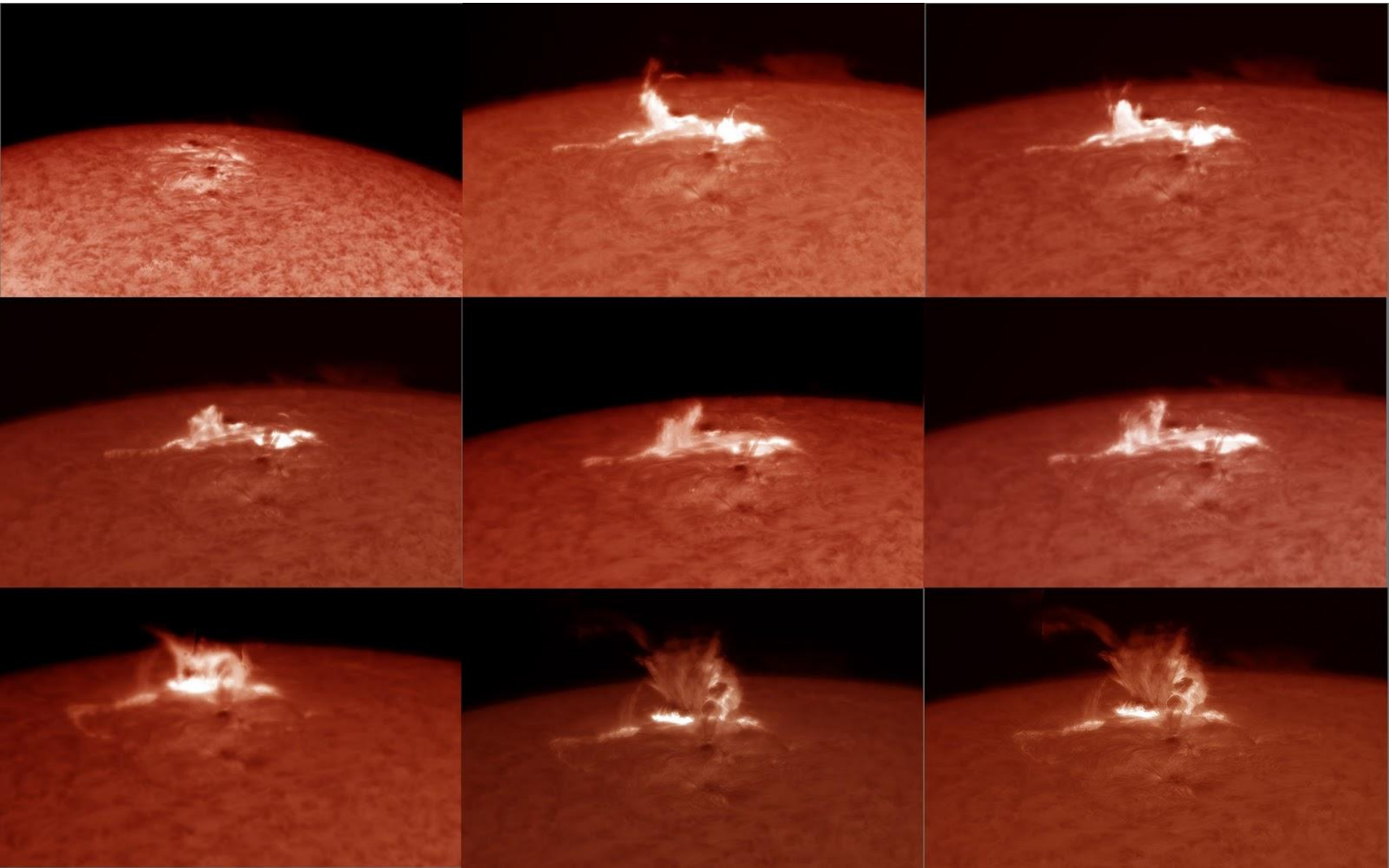

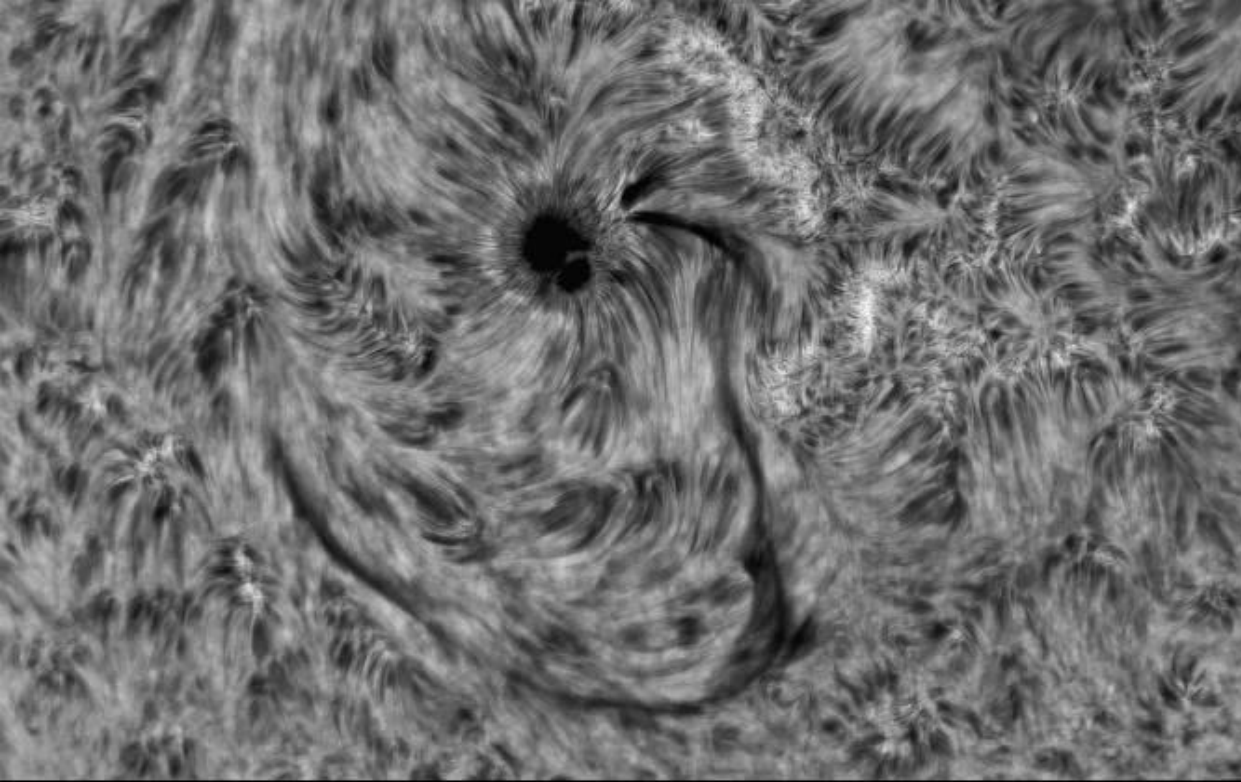
IMAGES OF A M-CLASS SOLAR FLARE



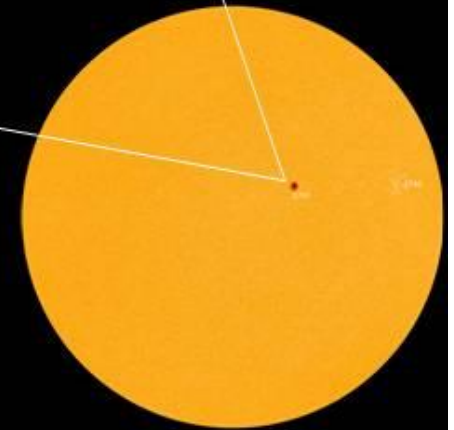


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CLOSE-UP VIEW OF SUNSPOTS AND ACTIVE REGIONS
